We believe that a new Celtic celebration in this legacy time-slot will further enrich Savannah's "St. Patrick's Season," which always gets off to a superb start thanks to the Savannah Irish Festival.

Looking to the future, our hope is that, year after year, we'll bring together community and international talent — from the domains of music, theater, and dance; crafts, food, and sports — to deliver to Savannah, just days before the annual parade, an enjoyable and inspiring Celtic-themed "féile" (the Irish-language word for a festive gathering). Again: we invite you to join us in the spirit of the old Irish saying, "togetherness is strength."
